SCAM TEXTS

Recently many people in the area received a text message from someone pretending to be from a bank stating their debit card was locked. That specific message wanted you to call the phone number listed in the text. Once you call that phone number or click any links in the text, they try to get your personal information.

Texts like this are created by scammers who acquire a certain area code. They send out a blanket e-mail that comes through to people's phones as a text. Cell phones are set by region, so people in the same area will all get the same message. Scammers often search local banks and pick one at random. It may not even be one you do business with. The texts are usually vague but have enough information to make you worry.



FRIENDLY REMINDER

Our debit card company, SHAZAM, may send texts or call you notifying you that your debit card has a hold on it due to suspicious activity. The text or phone call will contain information about a certain purchase, and they will only ask yes or no if you authorized that transcation.

WHAT TO DO

- NEVER click on links or attachments from an unknown sender
- Do not give out personal information if you aren't sure who you are talking to
- · Call your bank to verify any suspicious activity
